TRAVEL INFORMATION

There is customer parking available at the centre, including disabled parking. If the carpark is full there's parking nearby at the beach retail park as well as on street parking in our surrounding area, please no parking on the grass or blocking ambulance access via the front door. If your car isn't in a space, then it shouldn't be in the carpark.

Please note there are ongoing road works close to the climbing centre and this may effect journey times.

FOOD & DRINK

The café will be open upstairs until 17:30. It will serve coffee, hot food and sandwiches. A lift is available to get up to the café. There are also vending machines downstairs.

COMPETITION ZONES

An area is dedicated as a Competition Zone for the safety of competitors. Please note, that only competitors, judges and ClimbScotland Officials are allowed in the competition zone. Please respect these boundaries as they ensure the smooth and safe running of the competition. If you come into these areas during the competition ClimbScotland CCOs and Marshalls will ask you to move.

BAGS AND KIT

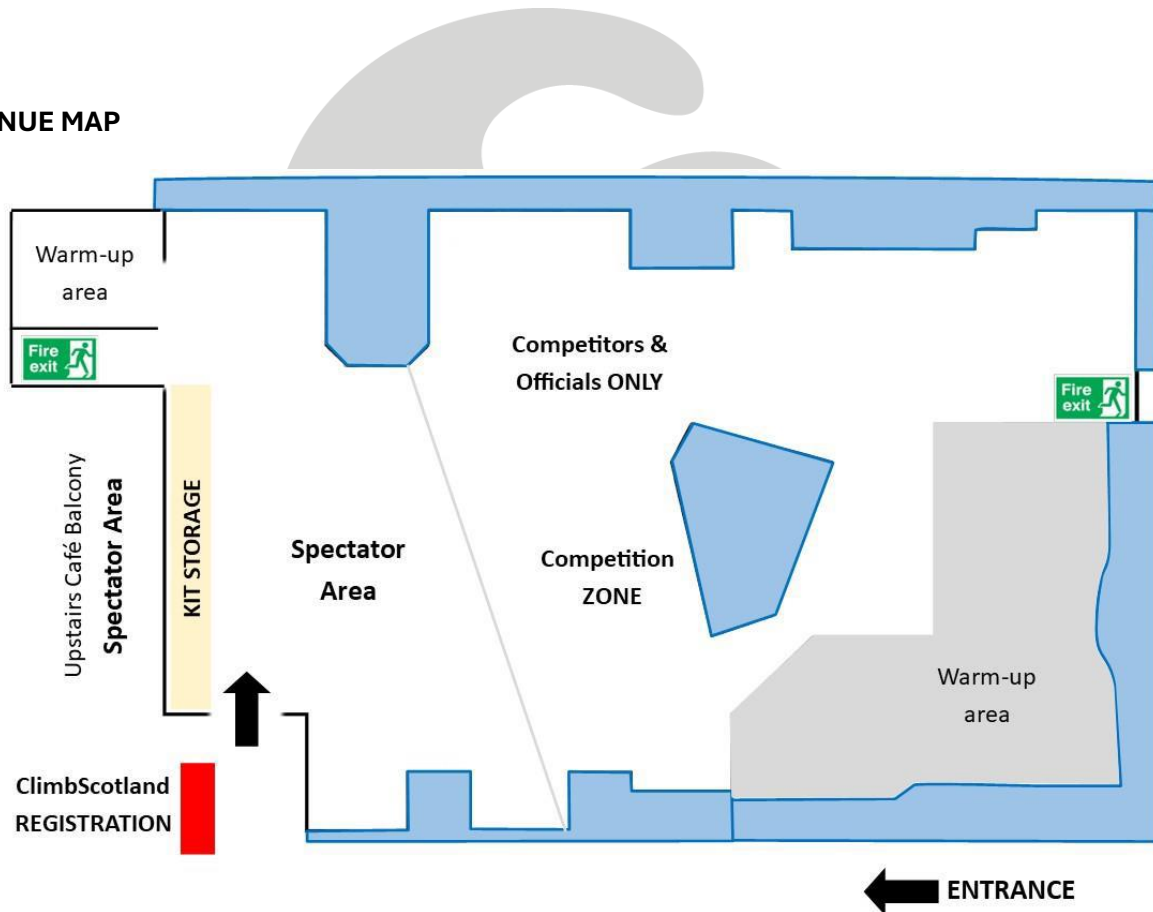
To help keep spaces clear for competitors, staff and spectators we ask that all kit is stored away in an appropriate place. Storage boxes will be made available under the balcony (between line 6 and 36) and lockers next to the training area fire exit.

CLIMBING AT THE VENUE AFTER THE COMPETITION

If anyone wishes to climb after the competition has finished, they **must** follow Transition Extreme’s standard entry procedure, and they **must** report to the centre’s reception desk.

Climbing during the competition (other than by competitors as part of the competition) is stickly prohibited, and even if the competition climbing has finished you will not be allowed to climb until after the presentations have been held, and the event has finished.
